Dear Parents & Guardians,

1. Governor's Order: "Safer-at-Home" - Today Governor Evers announced that tomorrow he will be issuing a safer-at-home order for the State of Wisconsin. There is little other information available right now, but details will be released tomorrow (March 24). As far as we know at this point, free meal delivery & pick up will continue as an "essential" service, even after the safer-at-home order goes into effect. We will let you know if we have any changes to our procedures based on new state requirements and health department recommendations.
2. Student Mental Health - If you or your student have concerns about your student's mental health and well-being, please contact Michelle Zagozen, Director of Pupil Services. A member of our Pupil Services team (school counselors and school psychologists) will reach out to your student. Please note: School staff are not licensed therapists and will not be providing mental health therapy. If you feel that your child would benefit from seeing a licensed mental health professional, feel free to contact Mrs. Zagozen to discuss local options.
