Parents,

We are sure many of you have questions related to the recent decision by the Wisconsin Supreme Court to strike down the Safer at Home Order. We are providing you the guidance that I received from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction this morning.

The Wisconsin Supreme Court yesterday struck down almost all of the "Safer at Home Order," Executive Order 28. The Court did not, however, strike down the section of the Safer at Home Order that closed public and private K-12 schools. That section of the Safer at Home Order, as well as the defined terms referenced by that section, remain applicable and enforceable.

Therefore, the Court's decision does not reopen schools, which remain closed through June 30th, the end of the current school year.

As we hear more guidance related to this issue we will pass it along. If you have any questions please let us know.
