Who: Anyone who would like to attend

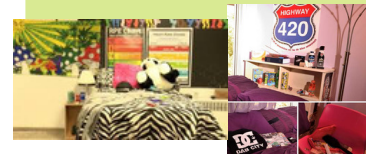
Why: The more we know, the more we can support our youth!
